Organisation Association Neuchâteloise de Course d'Orientation (ANCO, 50th anniversary in 2020!)	
Event Centre (EC) Pierre-à-Bot above the city of Neuchâtel (Switzerland). Coordinates N47.002557 / E6.911921. Accessible with public transport system: train station SBB Neuchâtel, then by bus 109 (10'). Parking is close to the event centre: fee CHF 10.00 for all 5 days or CHF 3.00 / day.	
Dates From Wednesday to Sunday, 12 to 16 May 2021 (weekend of Pentecost).	
Competition format 5 stages with overall result calculated taking the 4 best results (point values). Competition rules by Swiss Orienteering. SPORTident with SIAir+ activated. Stages 2 and 5 are "national events" for Swiss runners. Stages 1, 3 and 4 are regional events for Swiss runners.
