Organisation

Association Neuchâteloise de Course d'Orientation (ANCO, 50th anniversary!)

Event Centre (EC)

Pierre-à-Bot above the city of Neuchâtel (Switzerland).

Accessible with public transport system: train station SBB Neuchâtel, then by bus 109 (10').

Parking is close to the event centre: fee CHF 10.00 for all 5 days or CHF 3.00 / day.

From Wednesday to Sunday, 20 to 24 May 2020 (weekend of Pentecost).

Competition format

5 stages with overall results calculated with the 4 bests results (point values).

Competition rules by Swiss Orienteering. SPORTident with SIAir+ activated.

Stages 2 and 5 are "national events" for Swiss runners.

Stages 1, 3 and 4 are regional events for Swiss runners.

Stage 5 is considered a "WRE" event for DE/HE. Please open an account on "IOF Eventor".
